1. Environmental Responsibility

We are committed to environmental responsibility and guided by these principles:

- Encourage operational opportunities to minimize environmental impact, specifically focused on:
 - Air: Reduce gases and monitor air emissions where possible;

 - Energy: Assess energy consumption, become more energy-efficient and look for ways to use renewable energy where feasible; and
 - Waste: Work to eliminate, reduce, reuse, and recycle wastes from our products and processes.
- Strive to reduce or eliminate hazardous substances used during the manufacturing process.
- Comply with applicable national, regional, and local environmental requirements.
- Foster a community striving for continuous improvement regarding sustainability metrics.
